Unfortunately, this clause requires suppliers to have at least 5 years of experience selling the proposed HCI solution, which excludes our participation and that of many other companies. This limitation could lead to unhealthy competition. It is kindly request reconsidering the removal of this clause to promote a more competitive and fair submission process.	Due to nature of solution and its complexity we cannot remove the clause 5.5 completely as this will lead to have supplier having no previous experience of this solution. After technical compliance, financial bids will called from the technically qualified suppliers. Financially lowest proposal from the technically compliance proposals will be shortlisted for award. Complete tender will be awarded as turnkey.
