Abstract Submission Guidelines

We invite researchers to submit abstracts for consideration in our upcoming International Conference on “**BREAKING BARRIERS THROUGH DIVERSITY & INCLUSIVITY (BBTDI)**”.

Please adhere to the following guidelines when preparing and submitting your abstracts:

1. Abstract Structure:

The abstract should be structured with the following components:

- » **Background/Introduction:** Provide a brief context or overview of the research problem or topic you are investigating, and explain why the topic is important in your field/s. state about the gap is in the research.
- » **Objective/Research Question:** Clearly state the main research question/s, aim/s or objective/s.
- » **Methods:** Briefly outline the research methods and approach employed.
- » **Results:** Summarize the key findings or outcomes (if available).
- » **Conclusion:** Highlight the main conclusions and their implications (if available).

2. Length:

- » Abstracts should be concise, ranging from 250 to 300 words. Submissions deviating from this range may not be considered.

3. Clarity and Coherence:

- » Use clear and concise language. Avoid unnecessary jargon or technical terms that may hinder understanding by a diverse audience.
- » Ensure a logical flow of information from the introduction to the conclusion.

4. Keywords:

- » Include 3 to 5 keywords that highlight the main topics or themes of your research. This enhances the discoverability of your paper in databases and searches.

5. Tense and Voice:

- » Write in the past tense, if the research has already been conducted or otherwise. Use the present tense for general statements and conclusions.
- » Prefer the active voice for a more engaging and direct tone.

6. Avoid Unnecessary Details:

- » Focus on the most critical aspects of your research. Exclude specific details that are not crucial for understanding the main contributions of the paper.

7. Originality and Novelty:

- » Emphasize the originality and novelty of your research. Clearly state how your work contributes to the existing body of knowledge in the field.

8. Review and Revise:

- » Carefully review your abstract for clarity, coherence, and completeness.
- » Seek feedback from colleagues or mentors before submission.

9. Formatting:

- » Use a standard font and font size.
- » Ensure proper spacing and margins.
- » Follow any specific formatting guidelines provided in the “Call for Paper” under “How to Submit Your Abstract”.

10. Submission Instructions:

- » Abstracts must be submitted via email before deadline as described in the call for paper.
- » Clearly indicate the title of your abstract, the names and affiliations of all authors, (key thematic area and sub-theme) and contact information for the corresponding author as described in call for paper.

11. Important Dates:

- » Abstract Submission Deadline (for APWUC Member Universities): **January 03, 2024**
- » Abstract Submission Deadline (for American MSIs): **January 15, 2024**
- » Notification of Acceptance (for APWUC Member Universities): **January 07, 2023**
- » Notification of Acceptance (for American MSIs): **January 20, 2024**
- » Full Paper Submission (for APWUC Member Universities): **January 25, 2024**
- » Full Paper Submission (for American MSIs): **February 05, 2024**

12. Ethical Considerations:

- » Ensure that your research adheres to ethical standards, informed consent, confidentiality, anonymity, and promoting cultural sensitivity. Encourage researchers to consider the broader ethical implications of their work, including social and environmental impact, and to adhere to relevant ethical guidelines specific to their field.
