How to Submit Your Abstract

- » The corresponding author must provide the following information for the abstract submission:
 - Contact data Correct spelling of first and last name, position, department, affiliated University, email, contact number, Country.
 - Paper Title Full paper title for the presentation, (key thematic area and sub-theme)
 - Paper Abstract 250 to 300 word abstract
- » To submit, online submission through email <u>conferencepaper@bbtdi.net</u>
- » Submit your abstract (maximum 250 to 300 words), choosing from the presentation type.
- » Submit your Case study, Project Display, Product/Entrepreneurial display as per the required format provided on the website. (https://bbtdi.net/guidelines-for-case-study-product-entrepreneurial-display-and-project-display/)
- » Submit well before the submission deadlines
- » If your abstract is accepted you will be invited to register for the conference and submission of full paper.
- » Upon payment of the registration fee, you will receive a confirmation email containing your official receipt.

» Researcher would participate in various types of activities such as Panel Discussions, Research Papers, Poster Presentations, Case Studies, Project Display, and Entrepreneurial Showcasing. Selected Papers/ Articles will be published in HEC's recognized journals/ international journals.
